In April 2017, St. Louis County voters approved a ½-cent sales tax to “improve police and public safety” in each municipality in St. Louis County.

University City will receive at least \$1.5 million annually.

But Proposition P did not specify how those revenues should be spent. It’s up to citizens to communicate our priorities for Prop P funds and to demand transparency from elected and public officials.

The town hall meeting is your best opportunity to tell University City officials how to allocate Prop P funds.
