

Absentee ballots/mail-in ballots/in-person voting in Missouri for the November 3rd general election:

You can vote 3 ways: (1) Absentee or mail-in via mail; (2) In-person absentee starting September 22nd (starting Oct 22nd STL County will have 4 Absentee Satellite Voting Sites, click [here](#) for times and locations); or (3) In-person on voting day, Tuesday, November 3rd (STL County ballots are all personalized and generated electronically so you can vote at any polling location).

*Make sure you and your voting-age kids are [registered to vote here](#). Registration must be submitted online, in person, or [postmarked by October 7th](#).

If you want to vote by mail:

Absentee Ballots

1. Fill out an [absentee ballot request form](#) **ASAP**. Email your requests (with [an acceptable form of identification](#) if you have NOT voted in the city or county OR if you are a new voter) to: STL County: BOECAbsentee@stlouisco.com | STL City: stlcityabsentee@stlouis-mo.gov. Your requests must be received **by 5 pm on October 21st**.
2. We recommend that you mark excuse #2 (confining or incapacity due to illness (if you are confining bc you don't want to spread or get COVID)) or excuse #7 (for people at-risk of COVID-19) because they **DO NOT REQUIRE YOU TO NOTARIZE** your absentee ballot. All other excuses (besides 2 & 7) require you to have your ballot notarized.
3. Call the County/City Board of Elections the day you email the requests to make sure they have received them: STL County: 314-615-1800 (option 1 for absentee) | STL City: 314-622-4336 (option 2 for absentee)
4. **If you do not receive your absentee ballot and mail it by October 22nd, we highly suggest you:** (a) vote early absentee in person by dropping off your completed absentee ballot in person (wear a mask and bring ID); or (b) if you did not receive your ballot, you can vote early absentee by completing, at the election office, an "affidavit of a lost ballot", and completing a new absentee ballot (wear a mask and bring ID)* [note STL County absentee satellite voting sites](#). The deadline to vote absentee in-person is 5:00 p.m. the Monday before each Election Day. **Mailed-in absentee ballots must be RECEIVED BY CLOSE of polls on election day.**

Mail-In Ballots.

New this year...all Missouri voters are eligible to vote BY MAIL, but this alternative way of voting comes with restrictions different from Absentee options listed above. Ballots must be requested by USPS mail and MUST be notarized and MUST be received by mail no later than the close of election day on November 3rd.

Office Hours: Monday - Friday from 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. and one Saturday before each election from 9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. Starting Oct 22nd STL County will have 4 Absentee Satellite Voting Sites, click [here](#) for times and locations. **The deadline to vote absentee in-person is 5:00 p.m. on Monday,**

November 2nd. *Please wear a mask and bring [an acceptable form of identification](#) with you when voting in person.

Or . . . vote in person on November 3rd. In STL County, you can vote at ANY polling station because they will generate your specific ballot electronically at any location. *Please wear a mask and bring [an acceptable form of identification](#) with you when voting in person.
